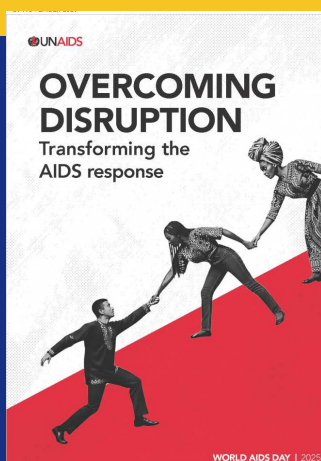

The MC MENA III Global Fund Grant Kick-Off Meeting

The MC MENA III Global Fund (GF) grant was officially launched in Amman, Jordan, under the banner “Regional Solidarity in Action: Sustaining the HIV Response.” The event marked the formal start of the 2028–2025 grant cycle and brought together representatives from the five participating countries, regional networks, implementing partners, and technical stakeholders.

As key partners of the Global Fund in this regional initiative, EMPHNET and the MENA H Coalition continue to play an essential role in supporting coordination, strengthening capacities, and advancing a unified, community-led HIV response across the MENA region.



The UNAIDS World AIDS Day 2025 report, “Overcoming Disruption, Transforming the AIDS Response,” stresses that while global crises have disrupted HIV services, progress is still within reach. The report calls for renewed commitment, stronger community leadership, and innovative, rights-based approaches to ensure no one is left behind in the effort to end AIDS.
